**MADE FOR EACH OTHER:
UNDERSTANDING GOD'S DESIGN
IN OUR DIFFERENCES (PART 2)**

Last week, in our bulletin article, I mentioned that God did not construct men and women as identical copies, nor did He design our variations by accident. Every contrast in our wiring was crafted with deliberate purpose. I pointed out that we are different **Physically** & **Psychologically**. Here are 3 more of 7 ways God created men and women differently, and why honoring these God-given distinctions matters.

3) We Are Different Emotionally - How we process feelings requires mutual grace. Men shouldn't be expected to respond to situations with standard tears, and women shouldn't be expected to just "toughen up." Men, don't talk to your wife like she's one of the guys—she isn't! Women process emotions deeply and generally don't possess thick, "rhinoceros" skin. Recognizing this emotional delicacy helps us treat each other with tenderness rather than frustration. **1 Peter 3:7** says, "Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered." **Ephesians 4:32** says, "And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you."

4) We Are Different Sexually - Our approach to intimacy is uniquely wired. For men, sexual connection is largely visual and physical. For women, it is relational and emotional. For a husband, physical connection often opens the door to emotional warmth. For a wife, emotional closeness and feeling cherished throughout the day opens the door to physical intimacy. Understanding this dynamic prevents misunderstandings and strengthens marital harmony. **1 Corinthians 7:3-4** says, "Let the husband render to his wife the affection due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband. The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. And likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does." **Song of Solomon 2:16** says, "My beloved is mine, and I am his. He feeds his flock among the lilies."

5) We Are Different Conversationally - It's often said that women speak around 25,000 words a day while men hover around 20,000. But the difference isn't just word count—it's style. Women love the details in stories and thrive on conversational connection, often wanting to lay in bed at the end of the day just to talk. Men tend to speak to deliver points or solve problems. As one husband humorously put it: "I don't mind listening to my wife... just not ALL THE TIME!" **Proverbs 18:21** says, "Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit." **James 1:19** says, "So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath..."

The devil is attacking our homes. We must safegaurd our families and pray for God's deliverance. As husbands and wives we must see our own value. Have a great week!
