We all go through trials. I went through a trial this year. My birth mom took my family to court for who I would live with. I was afraid, but my family reminded me to trust in God. He is in control. When we face trials, God is by our side. If we will reach out to Him in trust, He will guide us through our trials.

What is trust? Trust is relying on God as our safe place. Psalm 53:6 says, "When I am afraid, I put my trust in You." God is our good shepherd. We can look to Him for strength. When Peter stepped out of the boat, he could walk on the water to Jesus when he kept his eyes on Him. We need to keep our eyes on God.

How do we trust in trials? God tells us to give our worries to Him. 1 Peter 5:7 says, "Cast all your cares on Him, for He cares for you." My family talked to God in prayer. They asked their friends and family to pray and to be clear in their prayer. When Peter was in prison, everyone prayed for him. An angel guided him out of prison because God heard everyone's prayer. Matthew 7:7 says, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you." Prayer is our way to talk to God. Prayers are powerful.

How does trust build our relationship with God? Not knowing what would happen to me during the trial was scary, but it brought us closer as a family and closer to God. When we trust God in hard times, we see how He guides us through them. Psalm 23:4 says, "Even though I walk through the valley of shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me." Peter was so afraid when Jesus went to the cross. But through the strength of his relationship with Christ, he became one of the early leaders of the Church.

God does not say Christians will never face trials, but He says He is with us to guide and comfort us. Looking back on how God help me in my trial made my faith stronger. My family's story of faith in a trial can help others too. So, if you are facing a trial, pray. You will see that He has been right beside you the whole time.

"WHY I LOVE THE BOOK OF GENESIS"

The book of Genesis begins by telling us that God created everything in six days and rested on the seventh (**Genesis 1-2**). On Day 1, He separated light from darkness. On Day 2, He created the sky to divide the waters. On Day 3, He created land and vegetation. On Day 4, He made the sun, moon, and stars. On Day 5, He created fish and birds. Finally, on Day 6, He made animals and humans. On the seventh day, He rested.

Adam named the animals, including sharks, snakes, dolphins, and all kinds of birds. They had only one command from God: "Do not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil." However, the devil, disguised as a snake, tempted Eve. She gave Adam the fruit to eat. Both Adam and Eve were punished and were banished from the beautiful garden forever.

Years later, we read about Noah. He had three sons who helped him build an ark. All three sons and their wives were on the ark, along with Noah and his wife—only eight people in total were saved. Noah preached for 120 years, but no one listened. They all perished in the flood.

Another story in Genesis is about Abraham and Sarah. God promised Abraham that he would have many descendants. One son, Ishmael, was born to Hagar, and another, Isaac, was born to Sarah. Abraham received the promise of a son and also that all of humanity would be blessed through him.

Isaac had two sons, Esau and Jacob, who disliked each other and fought constantly. Jacob stole his brother's birthright and blessing. Jacob had twelve sons and one daughter, Dinah, and they also fought among themselves. There is also a story about Jacob being tricked into marrying two sisters.

One of Jacob's twelve sons was named Judah. Judah had a great-great-great-great-great-grandson named Jesus, born into that family through his mother, Mary. He is the Savior of the world! The rest of the Bible will tell us more about Jesus and His family.

These and many other great stories are found in the book of Genesis. Please study your Bible and visit a church of Christ in your community. Thank you for reading this article.
