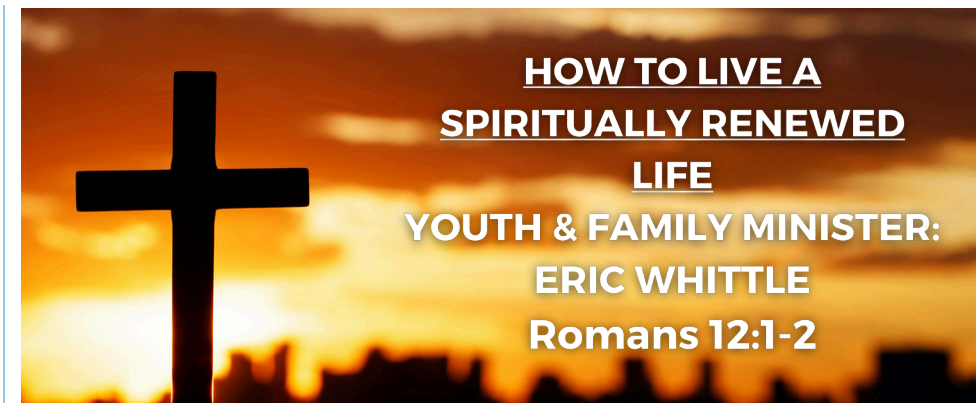

# 1 CORINTHIANS 13 STEVEN YAGER

February 14th - Valentines Day - The day of LOVE! This is a day to celebrate the idea of love. But shouldn't we love everyone everyday? In Matt 22: 37-39 Jesus tells us how we really should "LOVE". He says in verse 37 that "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." This means you love God with everything in you and then some. While loving God is usually easy, how about what Jesus says in verses 38-39? He states, "This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Loving yourself is sometimes a lot harder to do. But Jesus tells us we need to do it. We have to love ourselves so we can love our neighbors. Let's look at 1 Cor 13 to see what real love really is so we can know how to love God, our neighbor and ourselves.

1 Cor 13:1-3 states we have to have love in our lives to gain anything. As we read on in verse 4, the start of what love is and isn't, we are hit square in the face with one of the harder things for most people to do - to be patient. It's hard sometimes to be patient with God when we are waiting on an answer to prayer. It's difficult to be patient with our neighbor to do something and it is especially difficult to be patient with that person you look at in the mirror daily. But how do we do this, how do we have patience with God, our neighbor and ourselves? First thing to do is to pray for God to help us. Second thing to do is to practice, practice, practice. The only way you have patience is to learn it and you learn by practice. When you feel yourself starting to lose patience you stop, take a deep breath, hold it for a minute and think about what you really need to say or do. What would be the best way to show patience through love? Then show your love through patience. Show God patience by realizing that He will answer that prayer, might not be what you think it should be but He will answer it. Show yourself and that neighbor love through patience by just stopping and realizing that we all are human and do stupid things sometimes. Love you, love them and love God by realizing sometimes things don't happen the way we think they should.

But once we learn to be patient, or while we are continuing to learn it, then we also have to be kind to ourselves, and our neighbor. We must realize we are not perfect and you must be kind and loving to yourself so that you can in turn be kind to others. When we learn to be patient, and kind and loving (like 1 Cor 13: 4-8 says to do) then we will be able to love our neighbor and God with all of our heart, with all of our soul and with all of our mind. Love God, love your neighbor and love yourself with ALL of your being. Learn to love that person in the mirror, no matter what!!
