JESUS WAS BRAVE & COURAGEOUS (BY AUBRI TUCKER)

Joshua 1:9 says, "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." One of the most interesting things we can see in a person is their courage. When I think of courage, I think of Christ... All that He was, all that He did, and how He changed the world.

Jesus was the greatest person to walk the face of the earth. Ephesians 4:13 says, "till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ."
